## NEW MEMBERSHIP SYSTEM FOR 2018-19

The ACTSJC Committee has made the decision to implement a new system for club memberships starting 2018-19. From this point onwards, memberships will be done through Global Entries Online. This will assist us to better administer the club membership and maintain the accuracy of our records.

This process is simple.

1. Go to Global Entries Online [www.globalentriesonline.com.au](http://www.globalentriesonline.com.au)
2. Click the "Clubs" icon at the top of the page
3. Click "Become a member"
4. Under the ACT Showjumping Club click the blue "Become Member" button.
5. Fill in the details and pay via credit card.
6. For membership renewals in 2019-20, you will be able to update your details as needed.

The footing was amazing, the rings where huge, the grounds were immaculate and the horses where calm and happy. It had been a long trip for Team Cavalier and super groom Zoe Tritchler got to the task of making the horses and gear look spectacular to suit our surroundings.

We thought it couldn't be better than that until we hit Day 8 which had Stephen and Cavalier Du Rouet qualify through to the Silver Final. Stephen was second out in the final and set a cracking pace, he led the class and as it turned out in a nail biting finish could not be beaten. Should I mention .06 of a second separated 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>.

There was champagne and cheering, the win was extra special as it was commentated by Tim Dreverman and judged by none other than Michael Archer. There was nothing like seeing the true gentleman of showjumping galloping for his lap of honour on that very special horse.

Stephen brought a team of horses to the show, it was great to see his young horse Cavalier Carolus placing in the



height classes and Cavalier Ludicrous looking spectacular.

Under the tutelage of Stephen the young Kayla Hogg, Paris Ow Yang and Estella Dinnigan Wilkins were amazing in their classes.



The quality of jumping was astounding, we saw Izzy Stone smiling through her lap of honour after placing 8th in the Grand Prix on the first weekend, she also qualified into the Silver final.

We also saw some really classy rounds in the main arena by Jess Spence who came 5<sup>th</sup> in the speed class and had a 6<sup>th</sup> in the Silver qualifier. We were really excited that the lovely Ella Fisher's name was announced in the amateur ring getting a 5<sup>th</sup> place in her qualifier.

Steph Davies, who travelled with Izzy, had an outstanding show placing equal 2<sup>nd</sup> in Progressive rider with Ringo star, ridden by Gail Hellier and sold by Steph in August 2017. ACTSJC members will recall both horses were started by Steph with help from Grant Hughes and Stephen Dingwall as young horses. They both grew up at ACTSJC and have come a long way. Steph also was 2<sup>nd</sup> Championship Grand Prix on the first weekend, behind winner Emily Pursehouse by just 2 seconds. On the second weekend, Charlie qualified in 3rd place overall going into the progressive tour final, and was 8th in the class. Steph also acknowledged it was a privilege to ride at the show, Amazing ground made for wonderful jumping and happy horses.

We got to see the young horses compete in the main arena as they filmed part of an episode at Elysian Fields. There was also express eventing to keep the crowd cheering through a showjump and mini cross country phases.

To sum it up, this show was a really fun experience for riders and spectators. The jumps were colourful and challenging such as the aussie flag thongs, the candy canes, various water trays, huge colourful fans, and the 100 dollar bill wall. The area offered good restaurants for evening entertainment and was only a short drive to the gold coast or mount tamborine for rest days.

The show was well run and the grounds just beautiful. They catered for spectators with ample parking, lots of seating, club house, bar, picnic rugs, umbrellas and day beds for comfortable viewing. It

was a friendly show, spectacular for the horses and had heaps of trade stalls. We made new friends, there were lots of social events and we're just super proud of all the riders and horses that have come from our region. Congratulations to all the riders from our club and the results prove that hard work pays off. We hope that this show leads the way for more events like this in the future, good prize purses, active sponsorship, large committees and great ground for the horses.


